Blessed Holy Week! Its almost upon us and since we missed it last year, I for one will appreciate the significance of the events more than ever. We are using Mark's gospel this year which has an odd enough ending that those copying the original text created not one but two alternative endings. Look at Chapter 16 in Mark and see that scholars surmise that the ending at verse 8 is most accurate...." And they said nothing to anyone for they were afraid." Obviously, someone had to have said something about Jesus' resurrection or we wouldn't know about it today! Keep in mind that the stories about Jesus were passed around orally long before they were written down, and each Gospel writer had a particular perspective they emphasized in what stories they chose to include. Remember when Mark's gospel begins, there is no birth narrative, instead, we are introduced to John shortly before he baptizes Jesus in the Jordan River. Its soon time to meet for Bible study in person, so let me know if you are interested in particular times or days of the week.

It's also soon time for our postponed annual meeting: April 18 following worship in the sanctuary. Please be there so that you have a voice in the direction of Grace's ministry to our community and our world. If you are asked, please prayerfully consider serving on the church council. If you are available to serve, please let a member of the council know so that your name can be put into consideration. We don't like to "draft" people to serve....one of the reasons some folks are afraid to come to the annual meeting (we know it happens!) The newly elected council will consider each member's schedules so let the nominating committee know if you can be flexible.

The purpose of a council is to create a vision for ministry and help determine HOW we can do WHAT we deem to be important and one of the questions we should always be asking ourselves is WHY are we doing what we are doing? When people have a sense of purpose, they are less likely to burn out and will find meaning in the activity which in turn makes it more fulfilling.

Thanks to those who are leaving the council, those who are continuing on and those who are willing to serve!
