- † Meeting was called to order by President Jim Brogren
- † Devotions given by Traci Mace
- † Secretary report approved as printed.
- † Correspondence---Motion made and carried to place ad in D.L. Visitors Guide.
- † Ruby Kiihn spoke about Heifer International. She will give a temple talk this coming Sunday. An offering will be taken in November.
- † Finance report approved as printed.

- † Budget meeting needs to be scheduled. \$3,600 was the assessment for curb concrete work that was done in the eastern corner of church. Blace will be checking into this further.
- † Property Committee discussed the snowplowing plan for this winter. Jeff Leitheiser will be contacted by Gerry. Furnace and A/C was hooked up by Mark's Electric with a cost of \$675. Bill was paid with donation of \$1,000.00 given for the furnace fund. It was decided that the speakers should be moved back due to feedback. The piano will be moved back and 2 pews will be placed in the back instead. Also discussed the insurance claim that was submitted to Brotherhood Mutual to repair storm damage. Total cost is \$49,134.78. Blace will check with contractors.
- † Pancake breakfast held on Oct. 16th netted proceeds of \$274 for the Sunday School program.
- † Scholarship money will be given to students who will be attending the Middle School gathering to be held at Luther Crest Camp.
- † Holiday Bazaar will be held November 19th. The organizational meeting will be held November 6th at 10:30 A.M.
- † The need for special music was discussed. If anyone would like to provide special music or know of someone is to contact the office or the church council.
- † Piano will be moved up. Speakers will be moved back.
 † Discussion was held concerning the church council for
- 2023. All 8 of the council members' terms are up the end of 2022. Anyone interested in becoming a council member is to contact a current council member.

CONGREGATION HELP NEEDED

Several projects need the help and financial help from our Grace Lutheran Members. Please prayerfully consider if you can provide help in some way!

- 1. We received the assessment cost for the curb and gutter which was put in the southeast corner of the church lot. The total cost is \$3,569.00. This amount has to be paid by December 15, 2022 in order to avoid interest charges. Would you consider donating money towards this bill?
- 2. Do you have the key for our safety deposit box at Bell State Bank or know of someone who may have it? Due to an increase in box cost, the council has decided to close the box. However, to do that, we need the 2 original keys. We have 1 but are unable to locate the other key. If we can't give them 2 keys, they will need to rekey box which will cost \$150.00. Do you know where the other key is?
- 3. We submitted a claim for the damage of roof shingles and soffits that were damaged during the last wind storm. In order to claim recoverable depreciation, we need to notify Brotherhood Mutual within 180 days that we intend to complete the repairs. The actual cost for the repairs is \$49,134.78. Would you consider donating money towards this bill?
- 4. We would like to provide special music for occasions such as Christmas Eve. If you or know of someone who would like to share their talents, please let the office know. Everyone enjoys special music!
- 5. We are in need of people to replace the outgoing council members. If you or someone you know would like to serve a 2-year term on the church council, please contact the office, Jim Brogren Jr., or any council member. *Prayfully consider being a council member!*
- 6. Lutheran Disaster Response helps out during natural disasters such as hurricanes, tornadoes, and other places requiring relief.
- 7. Heifer International, an organization that works to end poverty and hunger is a project that used to be a project for the GLCW. Since they no longer exist, Ruby Kiihn would like to encourage church members to participate. You make a donation to buy an animal(s). Please consider giving a donation during the month of November




Sunday School






Sunday, December 4th--- The Advent Store will be open for the Sunday School Children to purchase gifts for their family.


